Important Information

1. Limited Spots: Clubs have limited number of participants and may fill up quickly. Once a club is full, it will be removed from the registration form. Registrations are processed on a

first-come, first-served basis.

2. Registration: Please register your child before the deadline expires. Only registered students

are allowed to participate in clubs.

3. Changes & Cancellations: Changes and cancellations are only possible during the first two

weeks of the semester. After this period, no changes or cancellations will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be submitted in writing via email to Ms. Zaric under

4. Minimum Number of Participants: Clubs require a minimum of 6 students to take place. If

this minimum is not met, the club may be canceled. In such cases, you can either select an

alternative club or request a refund.
